## *Room at the Inn*

Homelessness comes to families through the loss of a job, major illness, abandonment of a spouse or major provider and other factors. It is a crisis of logistics and emotions. With assistance from local churches, Room at the Inn provides the means and the support to help these families regain their independence.

Room at the Inn is a nonprofit program designed for **homeless families** that helps them achieve self-sufficiency and regain a home for themselves and their children. Shelter for the families is provided through a unique, innovative method by utilizing an Interfaith Hospitality Network of congregations and hundreds of volunteers throughout Weld County. Room at the Inn is an affiliate of Family Promise.

## *Our Mission*



In the past year, with the help of our community, Room at the Inn:

- Helped 122 people into housing and self-sufficiency.
- Provided 4057 shelter nights
- Provided 12, 171 meals
- Welcomed 3 newborn babies while in our care
